A new proposal with media coverage

Our presence at Construmat reflects PAPIK Group's intention to bring high energy efficiency construction into the centre of public conversation. The TVE news coverage placed our proposal before a wide audience, beyond the exhibition halls, and helped explain what it means to design homes conceived around efficiency.

The building model shown at fairs and in the media is the same one applied to every project: homes built to Passivhaus standards with the Eskimohaus system, designed to cut energy consumption without giving up comfort.
