

Open house in Mira-sol: seeing a sustainable home first-hand

An open day in Mira-sol to look inside a high-efficiency home and grasp the essential concepts before starting a project of your own.

Few decisions carry such long-term commitment as building your own home, and few are made with so little technical information to begin with. That is why we are opening the doors of a sustainable home in Mira-sol, within Sant Cugat del Vallès, so that anyone considering building can see first-hand how a bespoke, very high-efficiency home is made.

The day is aimed in particular at people with no prior technical background. The goal is not to close any project, but to offer a solid starting point: understanding what considering an efficient home really involves before taking the first step.

A talk to begin with good judgement

Alongside the visit, we offer a free talk conceived as a starting point. It explains the essential concepts that come up again and again in any efficient-housing project and that often raise questions: cross ventilation, Passivhaus certification, the energy mortgage and aerothermal systems.

These are terms that shape the comfort, consumption and cost of a home for decades. Understanding them from the outset allows decisions to be made with judgement rather than fully delegated. This session works as the foundation for turning a future house into a sustainable, very high-efficiency home.

Seeing it built, not just described

The value of walking through a finished home is hard to replace. It shows how the principles of high-efficiency construction translate into practice: a well-insulated envelope, airtightness, ventilation with heat recovery and the stable thermal comfort that results. At PAPIK Group we build our homes with the Eskimohaus system, and this visit is a chance to see it made real.
